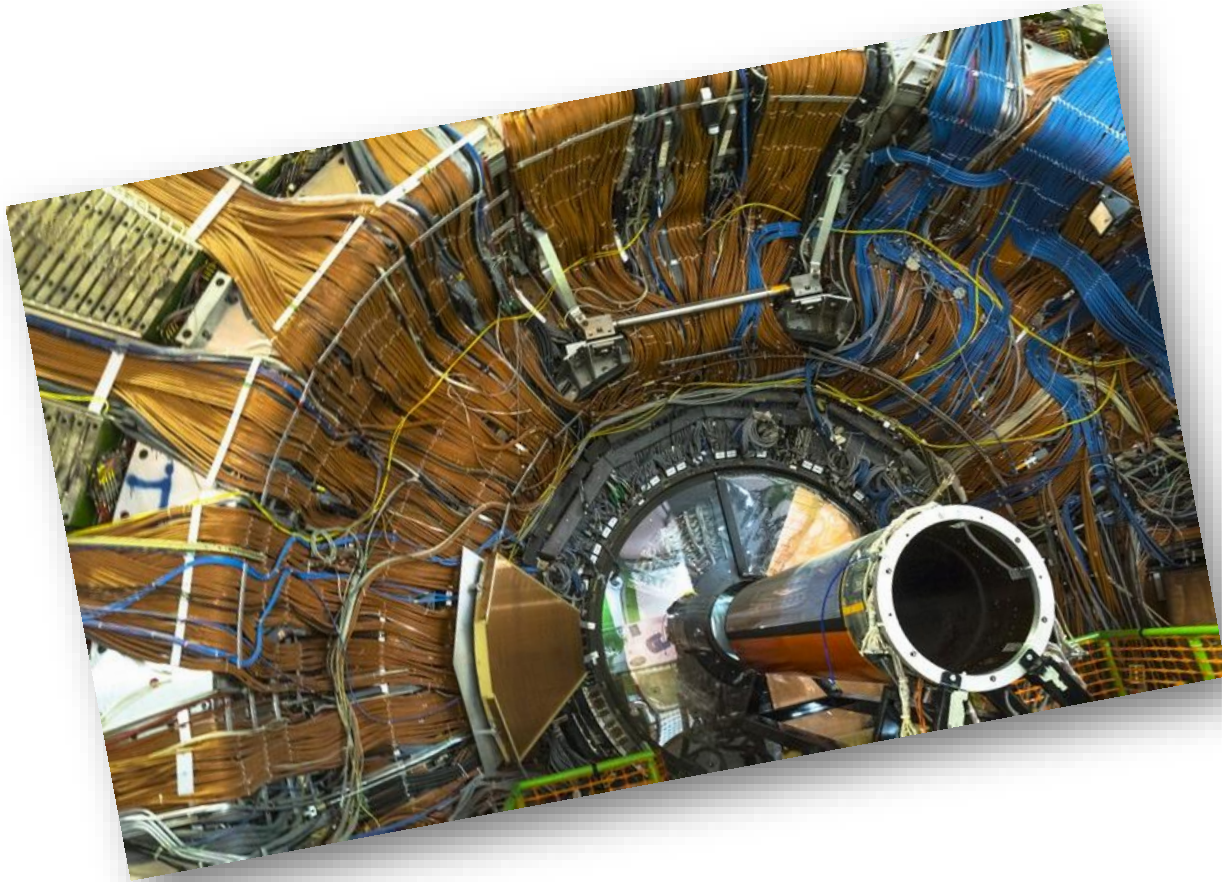

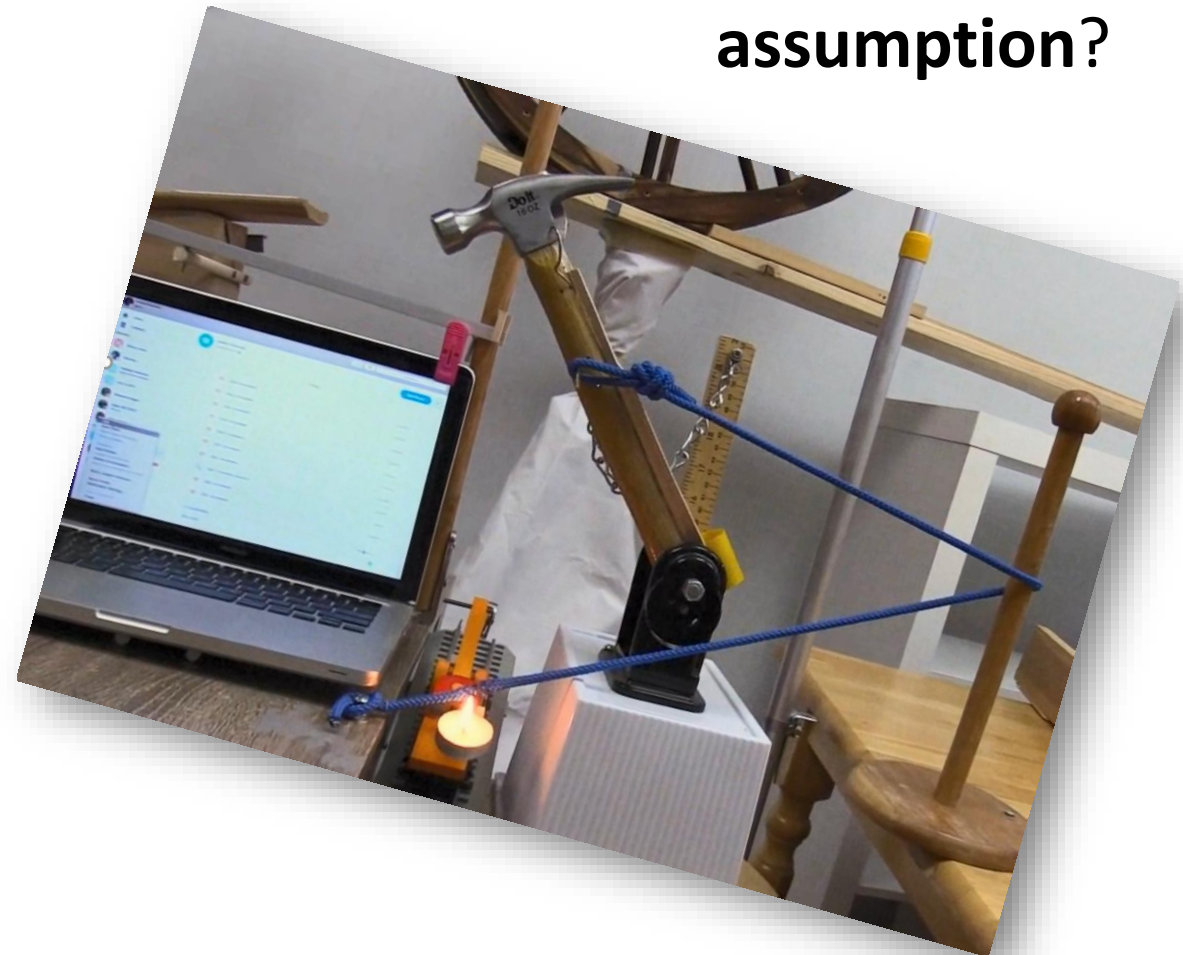

- Easy to use / adopt, with good tooling
